Public Contracts Review Board Notre Dame Ditch, Floriana

Reply of the Marsaskala Local Council (the Contracting Authority) to the Objection lodged by Antoine Xerri (the Appellant) with respect to Tender For the Upkeep and Maintenance of Public Gardens and Soft Areas in Marsaskala Using Environmentally Friendly Products and Practices (KLM2023/08)

Dear Chairman and Members of the Board,

A. First Ground of Appeal - Reasons for Rejection

- 1. The appellant complains that the contracting authority had initially failed to specify the precise reasons for the technical non-compliance.
- 2. The contracting authority concedes that it did not give the specific reasons in its initial communication to the bidder. This was a minor administrative oversight which was remedied before the lapse of the timeframe to appeal. The subsequent communication provided clarity to the appellant, giving him the requisite information to understand and contest the rejection (Doc A).
- 3. In fact, the appellant himself acknowledges, in his second ground of appeal, that the he was given the specific reasons for rejection and for the technical non-compliance, so much so that he was able to file an appeal on the merits, addressing the two specific reasons given to him for his technical non-compliance.
- 4. For these reasons, this ground of appeal is completely without merit.

- B. Second Ground of Appeal Technical Non-Compliance
- 5. In this ground of appeal, the appellant submits that his bid was technically compliant.
- 6. The contracting authority disagrees, as it found the appellant's bid to be technically non-compliant for not one, but two reasons.
 - i. Service vehicle lacks ERA permit
- 7. First, the appellant's service vehicle "does not have the ERA waste handling permits required in order to be able to carry out all the works included in the scope of the tender." The ERA waste handling permit is a critical and integral requirement for technical compliance within the tender specifications, since part of the scope of the works involves waste handling and waste disposal, which requires an ERA waste handling permit.
- 8. The appellant claims that his vehicle has this required ERA permit. However, the appellant's submission in this regard was lacking in certain aspects, and was deemed insufficient as verifiable proof of an active ERA permit.
- 9. Initially, the appellant submitted a document concerning a vehicle bearing registration number RXC002 for waste handling and waste disposal purposes. In this document he had expressly declared that he was "waiting for the new ERA permit" (Doc B). The required permit was therefore, by the appellant's own admission, not regularly in place at the time of the initial submission.
- 10. The contracting authority sought a clarification, where the appellant was informed, amongst other things, that: "The service vehicles should also be covered with the relevant waste handling permit." (Doc C).
- 11. The appellant subsequently submitted an updated document with information on the same vehicle RXC002 (Doc D). This contained a photo of the windscreen of the vehicle with an ERA permit expiring in July 2023. The updated document also

included what appears to be a letter from ERA, which the appellant is claiming to be the licence in question. But this letter lacks the vital formalities one expects from a licence, namely the official letterhead of ERA. The winning bidder in this tender submitted a proper ERA certificate with the ERA letterhead, which the contracting authority is attaching for ease of comparison (**Doc E**).

- 12. For this reason, the submission of a document without an official ERA letterhead, coupled with a photo of an expired permit, failed to meet the legal and technical standards of authenticity and current validity. It was deemed insufficient as verifiable proof of an active ERA permit.
- 13. This rendered the offer non-compliant with the stipulated technical requirements.
- 14. Furthermore, the reference to clause 4.2.18 in the appellant's appeal, pertaining to "other permits," does not mitigate this non-compliance. The clause explicitly relates to additional permits that might be necessary for the execution of the contract and does not pertain to the essential permits required for the core services outlined in the tender.
- 15. Therefore, the contracting authority correctly determined the appellant's offer as technically non-compliant.
 - ii. No certificates for key expert
- 16. The second technical non-compliance was the failure of the appellant to "submit the copy of qualification certificates of the key expert".
- 17. The appellant claims that it was sufficient for him to submit the CV and the Tree Specialist licence.
- 18. The tender dossier however expressly required the bidder to submit all the qualifications/certificates for the key expert.

- 19. The licence of a tree specialist was only part of the requirements, and was indeed also an integral element in view of the fact that one of the key experts had to be precisely a "Licenced Tree Specialist". But the tender however necessitated not one, but two key experts: (i) a licenced tree specialist, and (ii) a gardener/horticulturer/nursery grower. The bidder had to submit "qualifications/certificates for each key expert" (Doc F).
- 20. The appellant failed to do this. He appointed the same person as both key experts and simply submitted that person's CV and Tree Specialist licence, without the corresponding qualifications/certificates.
- 21. The appellant was given an opportunity to remedy his failure to submit the qualifications/certificates via a clarification question where he was specifically and expressly asked "to send copy of all qualifications (certificates)" (Doc G). In his reply, the appellant simply submitted the same exact document he had submitted with his initial offer, that is, the CV and the tree specialist licence.
- 22. Once again, the winning bidder in this tender submitted the requested certificates and qualifications for their key experts, which the contracting authority is also attaching for ease of comparison (Doc H).
- 23. Therefore, the contracting authority correctly determined the appellant's offer as technically non-compliant.

C. Third Ground of Appeal - Price

- 24. Lastly, the appellant claims that his offer is the cheapest, which seems to imply that if his appeal were to be upheld, he should be awarded the tender.
- 25. While it is true that his bid is cheaper than the winning bid, there are two other bids which are cheaper than the appellant's, which were also deemed technically non-compliant for the exact reasons the appellant's bid was deemed non-compliant: these other two offers had the same key expert and the same service vehicle as the ones proposed by the appellant. The documents submitted were exactly the same. This

means that should this respectable board deem the appellant's bid to be technically compliant, then the other two bids should likewise be deemed technically compliant, and should be reintegrated into the new evaluation of the tender, even though they did not appeal.

26. For these reasons, the appellant's appeal can never have a truly favourable outcome for him, in view of the fact that even if his appeal is upheld, his offer would still not be the most competitive given the other two offers that would be reintegrated into the evaluation.

In view of the above considerations, the Contracting Authority submits that the appellant's objections should be rejected in their entirety.

The following reasons hereunder explain why your bid was considered to be technically non compliant.

Justification: Key Expert Form

Clarifications were sent and bidder replied, one of which was not answered satisfactorily since bidder did not submit the copy of qualification certificates of the key expert. Bid is technically not compliant.

Justification: Waste Handling Permits of Service vehicles and respective log books. A clarification was requested and bidder replied however the reply did not present all documentation which is required to satisfy the tender requirements. The bidder appears to have commitment of use of only a service vehicle which does not have the ERA waste handling permits required in order to be able to carry out all the works included in the scope of the tender. Bid is technically not compliant.


