

PUBLIC CONTRACTS REVIEW BOARD

Case No 2035 CfQ 0010/2024 Call for Quotations for Provision of Cash-in-Transit Services to the Planning Authority

19th November 2024

The Public Contracts Review Board, having noted that by email dated 12th November 2024 the Contracting Authority following a Remedy sought by Ozo Security Ltd on the 8th November 2024 on the tender in caption has indicated that it has decided to eliminate the requirement that Economic Operators must be members of the Malta Association of Cash – in -Transit and Vaulting Operators (M.A.C.T.O.) to be eligible to participate in this call and that instead a self-declaration by Economic Operators confirming that upon the award they will render the services in accordance with the MCCA Standard SM 3200:2014 Cash and Valuables-in-Transit and Vaulting Services will suffice.

Further the Contracting Authority has indicated that it undertakes that once the Appellant indicates its acceptance of the Authority's proposal it will issue a Clarification to the tender to revise the call requirements and to extend the time period by the period of suspension of the call.

The Board deems the proposal of the Authority acceptable and since the Appellant has indicated that it is in agreement with this process directs the Authority to issue such clarification and extension forthwith.

Under the circumstances, this Board will not consider the Request for Remedy any further and directs that the deposit paid by the Appellant when filing the Remedy be reimbursed.
